- **Saukee Youth Wrestling Tournament** – On Dec. 30, the Saukee Youth Wrestling Club held their annual tournament. Two hundred fifty wrestlers competed, and over a thousand people attended this event.

- **PBIS** – Cool Tools Re-Boot Camp was held Fri., Jan. 6. Staff members reminded students of our behavioral expectations for the classroom, cafeteria, restroom, hallway, recess, library, morning routine and pick-up procedures. Student council members also performed skits that reinforced these expectations.

- **Math Fact Assessments** – January 25 and 26 we will be administering the middle-of-the-year math fact assessments. Third grade will be assessed on addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Fourth and fifth grades will be assessed on multiplication and division. We have been working hard on these, and I am anxious to see the results.

- **DIBLES** – Teachers just finished assessing student’s middle-of-the-year reading levels. We will utilize this information in our collaborative meetings to guide our reading and intervention groups.

- **Grades** – The second quarter ended Jan. 6, and grades were sent home Friday Jan. 13.

- **MAP Testing** – In a couple of weeks, grades 3 – 5 will be MAP testing for the first time. The data we receive from this test will be used in our collaborative meetings to drive instruction, curriculum, and interventions. I want to thank Ms. Hawley and the board for providing this powerful tool.

- Report cards went home last Friday. We are very pleased with the students' progress. We showed great improvement in our DIBELS Scores, and we are looking forward to evaluating the data from the District Math Benchmarks at the end of the month.
- The PBIS Team evaluated the discipline data for the first semester. There were 160 office discipline referrals compared to 170 at the same time last year. We celebrated the reduction in referrals and used this information to plan our January Pow Wow. We focused on positive behaviors in the classroom.
- The South School Safety Team of Brittney Shoemaker, Megan Kunkel, Dustin Secrist, and Angie Ruebush have been meeting consistently to evaluate procedures in the building regarding safety and moving towards the ALICE Safety Protocol.
