- Grades 3 – 5 will be PARCC testing on computer for the first time. We will be testing March 13 – 31.

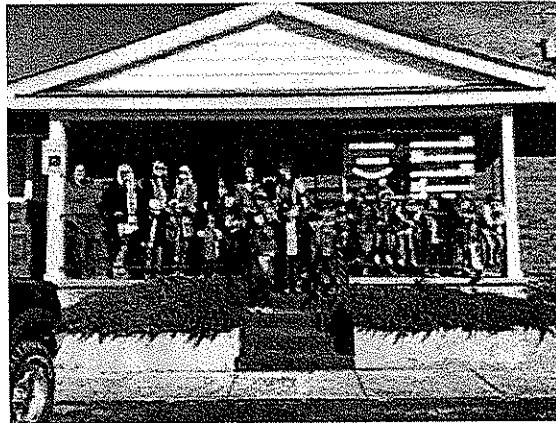
