On March 31, P.C.S. students watched an Autism Program presented by Taylor Sweeting. The focus of this program was to develop a better understanding of autism.

On April 7, fourth graders put on a jump rope exhibition for their classmates. This was the culmination of weeks of learning and practicing their jump rope routines. Mrs. Marable and Mr. Lanier organized and conducted this activity.

On the April 12 School Improvement Day, 3 -5 teachers completed GCN trainings. On May 4, we will be working on developing classes for next school year. 6 – 8 teachers met with the safety team to discuss changes in safety protocol.

During the teacher institute, C pod and some South School teachers participated in training for MyOn, which is a digital library. Once enrolled, students will have access to thousands of titles through their computers, tablets or other devices. This platform also provides teachers with resources and tools to support development of literacy skills. D pod teachers worked on GCN trainings.

Deputy Thompson is presenting the D.A.R.E. program to our fifth-grade students. We are fortunate that the Pike Co. Sheriffs Department provides this valuable program. D.A.R.E. graduation will be on May 3 at 6:30 in the PCS gym.
