Math Curriculum Update

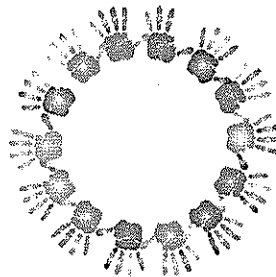
